Congress Booking Conditions

Arrival & Departure Airports

10th June – Arrival into London (We endeavour to meet all breeders personally depending upon flight details)

London Gatwick - Use airport shuttle bus for transfer to Copthorne Gatwick Hotel at own cost, approx GBP £4.00pp, payable locally. There are no activities on this first day other than a welcome reception & buffet in the hotel at 7pm.

London Heathrow - You will need to transfer yourself, first to Gatwick Airport using the airport bus then by Gatwick Airport shuttle bus to the Copthorne Gatwick Hotel, both at own cost. Please allow two hours for the transfer from Heathrow Airport to the hotel.

24th June – Departure from Edinburgh

9.00am ONE coach departs for Edinburgh Airport & ONE coach departs for Glasgow Airport – PLEASE allow ONE HOUR for each journey – then 3 hour international check-in, so return flights are recommended after 1pm for this transfer to be included, alternatively, if you have an earlier departure, you will need to take a taxi at your own expense.

27th June – Departure from Aberdeen

Aberdeen Airport – check out by 11am and either walk to the airport terminal, or complimentary shuttle bus.

Edinburgh Airport - 9am coaches leave for Edinburgh Airport – please allow 2.5 hours for this journey, and then 3 hours for international check-in, so return flights are recommended after 3pm for this transfer to be included.

Glasgow Airport – you can either take the tour coach to Edinburgh Airport then transfer by rail to Glasgow Airport, via Edinburgh City to Glasgow City, then airport bus.

The tour coach to Edinburgh Airport is included in the tour price, further arrangements will be at own cost. For example, private taxi from Aberdeen will be in excess of GBP £100.00 as this is a long journey (160 miles/3 hours).
